



Information on Indirect Sources Concerning the Capuchins of Albi (By Cédric Trouche-Marty, Archivist of the Diocese of Albi)

Printed Materials:

- *Histoire religieuse de l'Albigeois* by Louis de Lacger
- *Histoire générale de Languedoc* by Devic and Vaissette (publication of sources)
- *L'ancien diocèse d'Albi d'après les registres de notaires* by Auguste Vidal (index of notarial sources, important for the history of the Albi convent)

Part of the Albi convent library is held by the Albi Media Library and is accessible through its online catalog (by searching by current and former owners of the works). Some unidentified works may likely be found in the collection of old printed materials at the Diocesan Archives of Albi.

- And of course, don't hesitate to visit the Tarn Departmental Archives and consult the revolutionary records, the records of the Officiality, as well as the Albi city archives held there. Here are some references:

C279: Payment for the construction of the Capuchin church in Albi, 17th century

C375: Reconstruction of the church, 17th century

C403: Donation of twenty écus to the Capuchins of Albi for the construction of their monastery, 16th century

L554: Estimate of work on the Capuchin chapel, plans of the premises, 18th century

Q412: Inventory of furnishings, 18th century

Q314: List of leases, 18th century

4EDTCC327: General assembly of the Capuchin order in Albi

4EDTBB114: Confiscation of a sheep from the Capuchin servant, 17th century

4EDTBB28: The Capuchins request permission to establish themselves in Albi, 16th century
